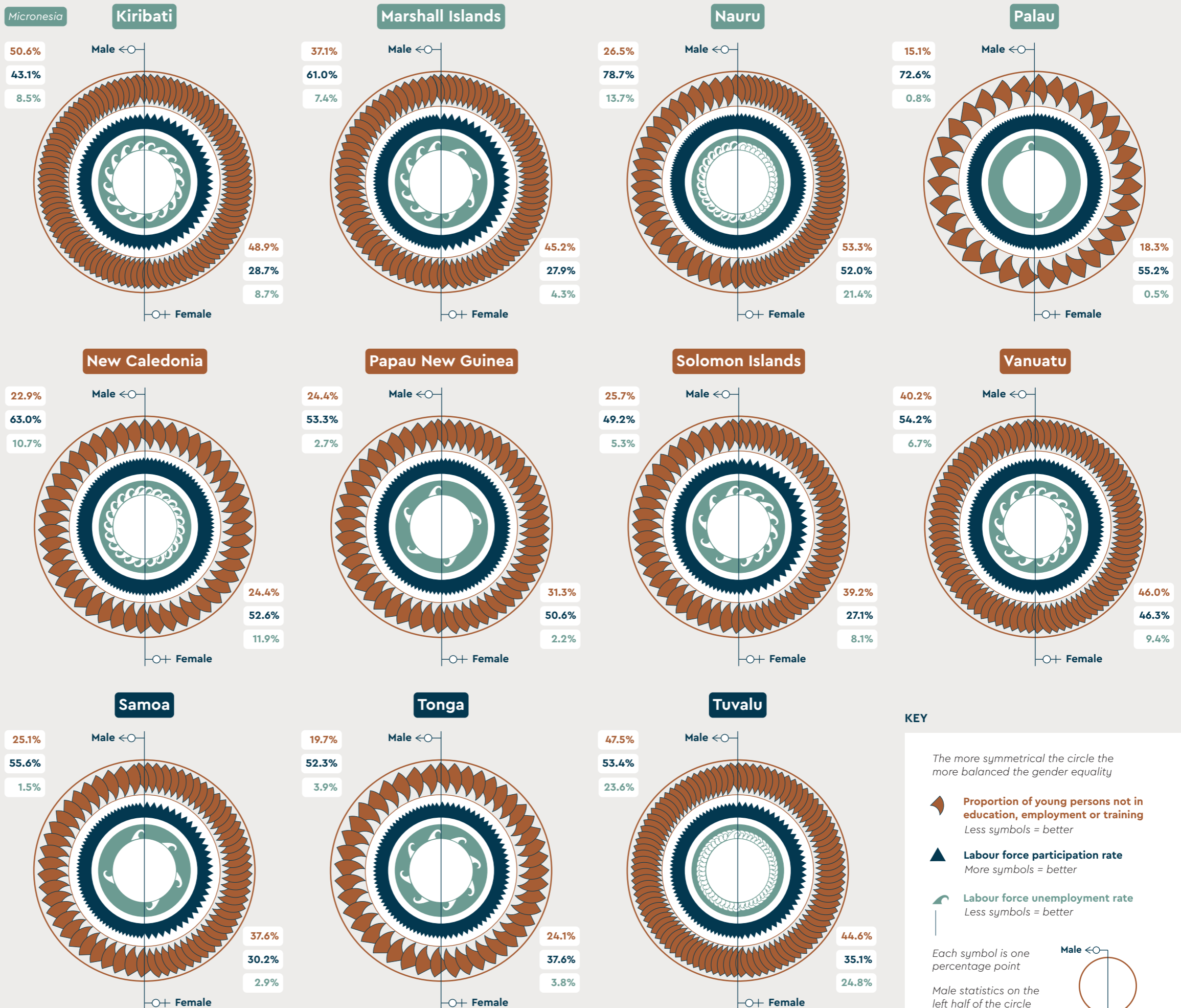


GENDER (in)equality

This data visualization presents labour market statistics from selected Pacific nations. Each circle represents a gender comparison of the proportion of young people not in education, employment, or training (NEET); the labor force participation rate; and the unemployment rate. The more symmetrical the circle, the more balanced the gender equality. Additionally, the visualization compares these metrics across different Pacific countries, highlighting the stark differences between each nation.



KEY

The more symmetrical the circle the more balanced the gender equality

- Proportion of young persons not in education, employment or training
Less symbols = better
- Labour force participation rate
More symbols = better
- Labour force unemployment rate
Less symbols = better

Each symbol is one percentage point
