



Measuring Violence against Women

Administrative Data

Data from response services is a measure of the number of women who report violence in New Caledonia. It is the tip of the coconut floating in the sea. To understand the extent of the issue, we must look beneath the surface and the bottom of the coconut.

Prevalence Data

Data from population-based surveys is a measure of the number of women in a population who have experienced intimate partner violence in New Caledonia. This data captures information from women who have not reported their experience. It also captures information on demographic, economic, and social characteristics to help identify risk factors and inform interventions.
